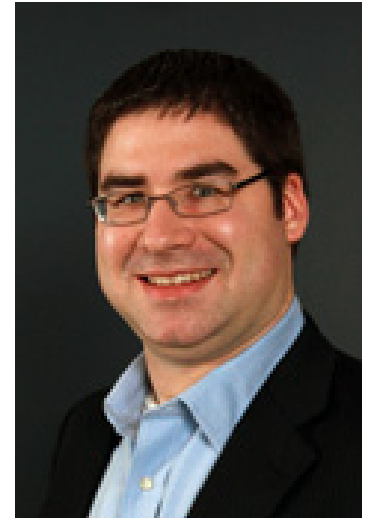


Brian Pittelko
