1. Original Articles between 6,000 to 8,000 words; word count does not include figures and tables (peer reviewed)
2. Research Notes (shorter articles) between 5,000 to 7,000 words; word count does not include figures and tables (peer reviewed)

3. Commentaries (opinion articles) between 3,000 and 8,000 words (reviewed solely by Timothy Bartik, Co-Editor)
4. Literature Review Essays between 6,000 to 8,000 words; word count does not include figures and tables (peer reviewed)
5. Book Reviews (reviewed by Neil Reid, Book Review Editor)

**Our review process strives for timeliness.** All submitted manuscripts are immediately reviewed by the editorial staff, which often includes an Associate Editor, to determine if the manuscript is appropriate for the journal and merits peer review. Manuscripts deemed appropriate are submitted to peer reviewers within 21 days of submission. Our goal is to provide authors with a decision (acceptance, conditional acceptance, revise and resubmit, or rejection) within 101 days of submission. Of course, requests to resubmit revised manuscripts will lengthen the process to publication.
